Creating a Tribe

You are on your 4th week and your kids hopefully have a good grasp of what is going on. Part of being a tribe is having a shared language. You will become more effective when they know what's going on and understand the consistency of the READ IT, SEE IT, LIVE IT, TELL IT strategy.

WHEN JESUS LOOKS AT YOU WHAT DOES HE SEE

“We’ve learned that truth is what Jesus sees. He sees things the way they really are. What do think Jesus sees when he sees you?”

HE SEES US WALKING IN DARKNESS

“Do you hate being lied to? I’m sorry to tell you that you have been lied to a lot. You’ve been told that money will make you happy. You’ve been told your value is based on how you look or how smart you are or how good you are at sports. You’ve been told you should do whatever you want as long as it makes you happy. Some of you have even been told you are worthless.”

WHEN YOU KNOW JESUS YOU KNOW THE TRUTH - HE LOVES YOU

“Jesus wants you to know the truth. He wants you to know he loves you.”

“It was not something you earned. He gives because He loves you. His gift is a free gift.”

THE TRUTH THAT SETS US FREE

“Then Jesus says to become His disciple so you can see who Jesus really is. The Light of the World. The Truth. The Savior. You can see who you really are. You are precious and loved. And you can see others for who they really are and you will love them, like Jesus does.”

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GIVE STUDENTS A CHANCE TO RESPOND

We all share a passion to make sure our children understand the gospel and turn to Christ in genuine salvation. As you present the gospel at FPKids it is important to remember that a true response involves both repentance and faith.

We don't need to confuse these responses to an invitation as repentance:

- Raise your hand if you want to go to heaven
- Repeat the sinner's prayer
- You need to be baptized
- Make a decision to follow Jesus today!
- There is no doubt that true conversations have come from these methods. These also can lead to a false assurance of salvation that can be dangerous. We ask that every decision made is discussed with a trained FPKids volunteer so that the kids can understand these Biblical truths. This will also help get them back to a local church.

The following are some points of emphasis to keep in mind as you guide kids to understand the Gospel:

- Talk a lot about who Jesus is (God-Man, Savior, Lord, King) and what He has done (died for our sins on the cross, rose from the dead).
- Make it clear that all people need their sins forgiven and will be judged for their sins if they are not saved.
- Urge children to turn from their sins and trust in what Jesus has done.
- Invite children to talk to you further about their relationship with God.
- Motivate parents to pursue further discussions with their children.
- Think long-term. Think how you can continually disciple children vs. how many "decisions" you can record.
- Pray for the children, and expect God in His grace to use the gospel to bring them to true, saving faith in Christ.
