### JESUS LOVES A GIFT

Jesus’ teaching sounded just as radical 2,000 years ago as it does today. Jesus is asking His followers to give away their love freely, even to their enemies. He is asking them to give away everything they have, even to people that they know won’t return it. Does Jesus just hate having things that bad? Or is it something else?

### WE TALKED ABOUT WHAT WAS BEFORE THE “BUT”

A few weeks ago we talked about what was before the “but.” Every time you read a verse that begins with “therefore” or “but” you should read what’s before it, but every time you read a verse you should also read what is after it. Did you know our verse this month is actually only half a verse?

### THERE IS A REWARD

Whew! I’m glad we are not skipping this. There is a reward! Jesus knows us really well, doesn’t He? He is asking us to give up a lot. He is not only asking us to give up our stuff, but also submit our attitudes. He is showing us what a true giver really looks like and also that a true giver is not without reward.

### OUR REWARD

“What is our reward?” you ask. Our reward is not more stuff. It stays true that Jesus doesn’t care much for the stuff we have in this world. Our reward is eternal. Our reward is the gift that God is giving us. Here’s where we get down to the main point; Jesus is teaching us not so much about ourselves. He is teaching us about God.

### IT’S HARD TO LOVE YOUR ENEMIES AND IT’S HARD TO GIVE NOT EXPECTING A RETURN

Jesus knows how hard it is. But Jesus is not asking us to do something that He is not willing to do Himself. When I told you Jesus is teaching us about God, I mean it in a very real way.

HAVE A STUDENT READ COLOSSIANS 1:21

**WE LOVE OUR ENEMIES BECAUSE GOD LOVED HIS ENEMIES**  
Did you hear that? Paul told us we were enemies of God. We made ourselves His enemies because of sin. We chose to live apart from Him and decide for ourselves what was right and wrong.

READ ROMANS 5:7-8

**BUT WHILE WE WERE ENEMIES... GOD LOVES A GIFT**  
Paul wrote that while we were still enemies of God, still sinners, Jesus died for us. You see, Jesus died for our sins on the cross not because we would have done the same for Him. He didn't give His life because of our great love for Him. He gave His life because of His love for us.

THIS GIFT IS CALLED... GRACE

Have you ever heard the term “grace?” I'm sure most of you have. It means that we don't deserve God's forgiveness, but He gave it to us for free. Grace is a free gift to people who made themselves enemies of God and can do nothing to earn it.

JESUS IS ASKING US TO LOVE A GIFT BECAUSE HE LOVES A GIFT

This gift of forgiveness is free, because it's a free gift from Jesus to you. You have a choice to believe and put your faith in Jesus today. That is the Gospel.

### NOTE TO CAMPUS COACHES:

Give students a chance to respond to becoming a follower of Jesus. We all share a passion to make sure our children understand the Gospel and turn to Christ in genuine salvation. As you present the Gospel at FPKids it is important to remember that a true response involves both repentance and faith.

### WE DON'T NEED TO CONFUSE THESE RESPONSES TO AN INVITATION AS REPENTANCE:

- Raise your hand if you want to go to heaven
- Repeat the sinner's prayer
- You need to be baptized
- Make a decision to follow Jesus today!
- There is no doubt that true conversations have come from these methods. These also can lead to a false assurance of salvation that can be dangerous. We ask that every decision made is discussed with a trained FPKids volunteer so that the kids can understand these Biblical truths. This will also help get them back to a local church.

### THE FOLLOWING ARE SOME POINTS OF EMPHASIS TO KEEP IN MIND AS YOU GUIDE KIDS TO UNDERSTAND THE GOSPEL:

- Talk a lot about who Jesus is (God-Man, Savior, Lord, King) and what He has done (died for our sins on the cross, rose from the dead).
- Make it clear that all people need their sins forgiven and will be judged for their sins if they are not saved.
- Urge children to turn from their sins and trust in what Jesus has done.
- Invite children to talk to you further about their relationship with God.
- Motivate parents to pursue further discussions with their children.
- Think long-term. Think how you can continually disciple children vs. how many “decisions” you can record.
- Pray for the children, and expect God in His grace to use the Gospel to bring them to true, saving faith in Christ.

### HAVE A STUDENT PRAY THE PRAYER OF GOING

“As we go from our time together, will someone please come and pray a prayer for us? Start by asking the Lord to be with us as we go from this place back into our school and that His Word would remain with us...”

### RELEASE KIDS TO CLASS
