JESUS LOVES FAITHFULNESS

This month we've talked about faithfulness. We've talked about how Jesus has called many to follow Him. You would think that everyone would do it. There were people who heard it directly from the mouth of Jesus, "Follow Me," but they didn't. It's crazy to think about that now isn't it? I mean... it's Jesus we're talking about.

Why did they say no to Jesus? Why, when they heard the call of Jesus did they think about their lives, their money, their families and their homes? Let's recall what Jesus said.

RECITE AND DO MOTIONS OF LUKE 9:62

ARE YOU FIT FOR SERVICE IN THE KINGDOM OF GOD?

Are you faithful enough to follow Jesus? Would you give up everything you own for Him today? Would you leave your home and your family today for Him? These are hard questions. Why does Jesus ask this? Why does He ask this of us? It's hard.

DOES THIS MAKE YOU UNCOMFORTABLE?

I'm going to tell you the truth. Jesus loves you. He loves you so much He's willing to make you uncomfortable. He asks these hard things because it goes straight to the deepest part of us. Are we really faithful? Are we really worthy?

LET'S TALK ABOUT ANOTHER TIME IN JESUS' LIFE RIGHT NOW

Before Jesus was going to be arrested, beaten and crucified, He was praying in a garden. He was crying and scared. He was on His face on the ground. Part of Him wanted this to not have to happen. Part of Jesus wanted there to be another plan... another way to save the world. But He knew this was the plan. He would have to die, to pay the price for our sin and save the world.

“My Father, if this cannot pass away unless I drink it, Your will be done.”

Jesus was talking to His Father and saying, “If to save the world I must die, Father, I will be faithful and do what you’ve asked me to do.” Jesus was faithful. He was willing to die for us, not because it was easy or that He wanted to. He was in agony about it. It made Him uncomfortable. But He was faithful. He had faithfulness.

WHAT MADE THE DISCIPLES WHO DID SAY YES TO JESUS FIT TO SERVE?

Were they perfect? No. Were they any better than you and me? No. What makes them faithful? What makes them faithful and not the others? It is a simple thing.

THEY SAID YES

They said yes to Jesus and they got up. You can say yes to Jesus. You can get up. Jesus is asking you today, not if you are faithful enough to follow Him. He is asking if you will believe in His faithfulness. Will you look to Him to make you faithful? Will you say yes?

NOTE TO CAMPUS COACHES:

Give students a chance to respond to becoming a follower of Jesus. We all share a passion to make sure our children understand the Gospel and turn to Christ in genuine salvation. As you present the Gospel at FPKids it is important to remember that a true response involves both repentance and faith.

WE DON'T NEED TO CONFUSE THESE RESPONSES TO AN INVITATION AS REPENTANCE:

- Raise your hand if you want to go to heaven
- Repeat the sinner's prayer
- You need to be baptized
- Make a decision to follow Jesus today!
- There is no doubt that true conversations have come from these methods. These also can lead to a false assurance of salvation that can be dangerous. We ask that every decision made is discussed with a trained FPKids volunteer so that the kids can understand these Biblical truths. This will also help get them back to a local church.

THE FOLLOWING ARE SOME POINTS OF EMPHASIS TO KEEP IN MIND AS YOU GUIDE KIDS TO UNDERSTAND THE GOSPEL:

- Talk a lot about who Jesus is (God-Man, Savior, Lord, King) and what He has done (died for our sins on the cross, rose from the dead).
- Make it clear that all people need their sins forgiven and will be judged for their sins if they are not saved.
- Urge children to turn from their sins and trust in what Jesus has done.
- Invite children to talk to you further about their relationship with God.
- Motivate parents to pursue further discussions with their children.
- Think long-term. Think how you can continually disciple children vs. how many “decisions” you can record.
- Pray for the children, and expect God in His grace to use the Gospel to bring them to true, saving faith in Christ.
