Memorization is Important

You will have kids that understand what you are teaching on many different levels. Memorization is a key step for all of them though. Even if they don't fully comprehend everything, memorizing what Jesus said is planting seeds in them that we can trust God will nurture.

Read It Recap

We really want each month to be very simple. We want to create a pattern that into months 2 and 3 the students will start to recognize. For the kids to really memorize these verses they are going to have to see them every week.

// LIVE IT

GIVE STUDENTS THE RIGHT EXAMPLES OF HOW TO LIVE AS A PEACEMAKER
IN THE 5 AREAS OF THEIR LIFE

SCHOOL EXAMPLE

“We’ve talked about how bullying is a huge problem in schools. It affects everybody. Do you want to know how to end bullying? It’s not by standing up to bully to make them feel just as bad as they made you feel. You just became a bully just like them. You just doubled the bullying. But you repay by treating others with love and respect, because you know how it feels to not feel that way. You have repayed mistreating with love and good.”

ONLINE EXAMPLE

“Put yourself in the middle of online bullying. You be the person to say that it needs to stop.”

FRIENDS EXAMPLE

“Forgive someone and rekindle a friendship that has gone bad. Don’t let a difference you and someone else has had become what defines you.”

FAMILY EXAMPLE

“Brothers and Sisters fight right? Who here has a brother or sister that you fight with? Next time they do something you don’t like, instead of repaying them in revenge tell them that you love them. See how they respond to that.”

FIELD EXAMPLE

“Who here plays competitive sports? Competition brings out the worst in people. But you don’t have to play to get back at people. You can play FOR something. You can play not to beat them, but to play your best. That way you can not only win the game, but also win a friend.”

DO A LIVE IT CHALLENGE

Give the students labels to make Shoe labels.

Have the Students write on them: LOVE. DO GOOD. BLESS. PRAY.

Have put them on the backs of their shoes or somewhere else on their clothes.

Whenever someone else asks them what they are, they should tell them what Jesus said on how to be a peacemaker.
