Jesus Said

When we talk about our verses this year we want to try and stay away from the phrase “the Bible says.” It’s important to emphasize to our FPKids that a real person said these things and a real person wrote them down. So instead we want to say “Jesus Said” and “John wrote it down.”

// READ IT

WHAT JESUS SAID IS FOUND IN MATTHEW, MARK, LUKE, JOHN AND ACTS

“Last month we talked about how what Jesus said is only found in the Bible. It is the only place. Who can tell me where you can find what Jesus said in the Bible?”

Where in the Bible can you find what *JESUS SAID*?

YOU SAY: Matthew, Mark, Luke, John and Acts

|| KIDS SAY: Matthew, Mark, Luke, John and Acts

“Matthew, Mark, Luke and John are 4 books in the Bible. Together, they are called the Gospels. The word Gospel means Good News.

What does Gospel mean?

YOU SAY: Good News || KIDS SAY: Good News

They are the good news because they tell what Jesus said and did. The book of Acts is about the first years after Jesus rose from the grave and went up to Heaven. In Acts, some of the last things Jesus said are recorded.
