ASK STUDENTS IF THEY TAUGHT ANYBODY THE VERSE
LET 1 OR 2 RESPOND AND SHARE

REMIND THE KIDS ABOUT MARKS

“Every month, we are going to talk about a mark. We have a mark that goes with the Jesus said verse.”

YOU SAY: Say Mark || KIDS SAY: Mark

“What Jesus said challenges us to think differently. If you hold and value what Jesus says it will change you. It changes how we think, what we do and how we see things. It also changes how people see us. Think of it like a tattoo. It’s on us. It’s permanent and visible to others. How awesome is that? If we value what Jesus said and let it change us, we become like Jesus! And when others see that change in us they see Jesus on us. It all comes from Jesus teaching us. It comes from Jesus.”

Kids are Performers

Kids are natural performers, but sometimes we get in the continuous pattern of having them sit and listen. Try in everything you teach to get kids up front with you doing something. Then your lesson becomes visual as well as audible.

Read It Recap

We really want each month to be very simple. We want to create a pattern that into months 2 and 3 the students will start to recognize. For the kids to really memorize these verses they are going to have to see them every week.

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// SEE IT

THIS MONTH'S MARK IS PEACEMAKING -
"SHOWING LOVE INSTEAD OF REVENGE"

WE ALL KNOW WHAT IT'S LIKE.

"Does anybody here have an enemy? Someone you just don't get along with? How many of you have been bullied before? How many of you have been picked on? I bet most of you do. Some statistics show that more than 75% of students say they have been bullied."

EVEN JESUS KNEW WHAT IT WAS LIKE

"Jesus knew what it was like to be bullied and picked on too. Even though He did nothing to deserve it. Sometimes when Jesus would teach, people would call Him names and sometimes try to stone Him. Many or all of you may know about the trial and crucifixion of Jesus. He was mocked, beaten and killed."

WHAT IS THE NATURAL THING TO DO?

"What is your first instinct when someone does something bad to you? It's to get them back right? Someone calls you a name or you call them something right back. Someone pushes you and you push them back. When your parents and teachers see that, who gets in trouble? You both do."

WHAT DID JESUS TEACH?

"But Jesus, who went through so much hurt from other people, taught, 'Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.'"

3 THINGS TO UNDERSTAND

"1. Peacemaking is not doing nothing. Peacemaking is showing love in every situation, even bad ones. It is action. Actively choosing to show love instead of revenge."

"2. Revenge only serves you. Peacemakers want good for others. Even for those who don't deserve it. Revenge only shows you are just the same as the other person. You did the same back to them. They did something wrong and instead of doing good you did something wrong too."

"3. Because it shows others what God is like. In Jesus' first public teaching He said, "Blessed are the Peacemakers, for they will be called Children of God. When you show love to someone who doesn't love you, you are Christ-like. You act like the Son of God."

YOU ARE DIFFERENT

"You are called to be different when it's not easy being different. You repay hate with love and good. You repay curses with blessing. You repay those who hurt and mistreat you by asking God to help them. When they crucified Jesus on the cross, soldier took Jesus' clothes and gambled to see who would get them. What a terrible thing to do. Even in moments like that, Jesus prayed, 'Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.' Luke 23:34."
