THIS MONTH'S MARK IS SERVANTHOOD
"HUMBLING YOURSELF"

"There are times when we can really relate to Disciples of Jesus because they said things that we would say. One of those times was when John and James asked Jesus if they could sit at the right and left side of Jesus in His Kingdom. That sounds like something I would ask. It is very telling on how they viewed power and authority. They wanted to sit next to Jesus and His throne in seats that made them important. Of course the other disciples became annoyed by what they said. Why should they get to sit in seats of power over them?"

WHERE DOES A KING SIT?

(Ask a kid to come sit down and sit like a king does. You may even have another kid come and kneel like a bench so the king can sit on him. Feed into the ego of the "king". He sits high with all below him. Others come to kneel before him. Others come to serve him. He looks down on them.)

JESUS TAUGHT THEM ABOUT TRUE GREATNESS

"Jesus called them together and said, 'You know that those who are regarded as rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them. Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant.' Mark 10:42-43

JESUS REDEFINED WHAT IT MEANS TO BE GREAT

"You have been told over and over how great you can be by Nike, Underarmor and music. You've been told that you can be wealthy, influential, important and powerful. You've been told to aspire to be the boss! But Jesus said if you want to be truly great, you have to become a servant. Jesus changed what greatness looked like. He redefined it and showed us what it looks like. It's about how you look at yourself and others."

ANOTHER TIME JESUS SAID TO THE DISCIPLES AT THE LAST SUPPER.

'The kings of the Gentiles lord it over them; and those who exercise authority over them call themselves Benefactors. But you are not to be like that. Instead, the greatest among you should be like the youngest, and the one who rules like the one who serves. For who is greater, the one who is at the table or the one who serves? Is it not the one who is at the table? But I am among you as one who serves.' Luke 22:25-27

JESUS CAME TO SERVE

Wow, the King of Kings and Lord of All washed feet. He didn't ignore the poor and sick, He looked them in the face. He took their hands. He didn't punish, He forgave. He didn't conquer death and the world with a sword and lightning bolts. He conquered it by suffering and dying.

"It is change in us that comes from Jesus. Our Mark this month is Servanthood. Servanthood humbling yourself."
